

Percent Change in Population







Poverty Rate (ACS)

Poverty is considered a *key driver* of health status.








Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2012-16



Housing Constructed Before 1960, Percent by Tract, ACS 2012-16





Residential Vacancies, Percent by Tract, HUD 2016-Q4




Housing Units Lacking Complete Plumbing Facilities, Percent by Tract, ACS 2011-15





Nutrition

Free and Reduced Lunch Program

Within the report area 5,706 public school students or 21.48% are eligible for Free/Reduced Price lunch out of 26,563 total students enrolled. This indicator is relevant because it assesses vulnerable populations which are more likely to have multiple health access, health status, and social support needs. Additionally, when combined with poverty data, providers can use this measure to identify gaps in eligibility and enrollment.



The below table shows that according to the American Community Survey (ACS), 2,874 households (or 6.26%) received SNAP payments during 2016. During this same period there were 1,830 households with income levels below the poverty level that were not receiving SNAP payments.

















































Q43. 43. Gender of individual taking survey





Q44. 44. Ethnicity of individual taking survey


















