

Dear Community,

Community Assessments provide organizations across the county with statistical information that allows for tracking and trending of key indicators within a specific community. Wright County Community Action (WCCA) strategically completes a full assessment every three years with a specific focus on the conditions of poverty in Wright County and the 18 western Hennepin communities we serve. We do this by surveying participants in our programs, the community at large, reviewing statistical data, and hosting conversations that allow us to inspect issues from every angle.

At WCCA, we understand that a community can change dramatically in three years. For this reason, we commit to making annual updates to our assessment data. While we usually will not conduct a community-wide survey, or hold in-depth conversations, we will update the statistical information and report any significant shifts that have happened throughout the community.

The 2019 Annual Update came with a unique set of challenges. As one of the fastest growing counties in Minnesota, estimates show our population increasing by nearly 12,000 people (9.3%). This large growth makes the detailed estimates difficult to calculate. The smaller or more rural communities are even more difficult, specifically the small cities who have seen significant growth. One of the tools that the US Census Bureau uses to gain insight into communities is the American Community Survey (ACS). The ACS is the only place for comparable local data and provides organizations with data to determine where and how to distribute funding. In December 2018, the US Census Bureau released the 2017 ACS results. These results show significant shifts from the 2016 ACS Results. We use the ACS survey to determine very detailed profiles of the community. An example of what we look for is the number of children living in poverty between the ages of zero and six and narrowing down by zip code. As these data elements zoom closer into the topic, the margin of error begins to climb.

While you review the data illustrated in the following pages, we ask that you consider the margin of error. The 2017 ACS does not align with our boots-on-the-ground experience. Therefore, some of the results are not an accurate representation of our community. For that reason, we have included our 2017 agency demographics.

Thank you for taking the time to read our 2019 Assessment Update. We hope this information can help you identify goals for your community and inspire you to take action to fight poverty.



Percent Change in Population






Population, Density (Persons per Sq Mile) by Tract, ACS 2013-17





#### Median Age by Tract, ACS 2013-17








### Race Demographics

















#### Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by County, SAIPE 2017









Percent Population in Poverty





#### Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17











Single Parent Family Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17




### Poverty Rate Change (Age 0-17)












Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - April







Median Household Income by County, SAIPE 2017







Average Commute Time (mins)







Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - April







Percent Population with No High School Diploma






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Population with No High School Diploma (Age 18+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17


#### Median Age by Tract, ACS 2013-17

The Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA), the MCA-Modified, and the Minnesota Test of Academic Skills (MTAS) are state tests that help districts measure student progress toward Minnesota's Academic Standards, the state standards of what students should know in each grade. These assessments meet the requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA); mathematics and reading assessments are also used in federal school accountability systems.

The percentage meeting or exceeding standards indicates the share of students achieving the expected standards for their grade level. Students take one test in reading each year in grades 3-8 and in grade 10. In grade 11 students take the MCA, but students who receive special education services and meet eligibility requirements are required to take the MCA-Modified or the MTAS.

MCA exams are administered during the spring, so the data year represents the second year of an academic year. For example, 2018 data represent the 2017-2018 school year.

Data are for public school districts only (primary, charter, and special districts). Private schools are not i
