Currently servicing senior housing communities within Wright County.

2

Residents are given an initial intake information session where they can enroll in the program.

3

Monthly menus and deliveries are provided on consistent days each month.

4

Volunteers pack and deliver the orders directly to the clients' doors.

- Solution to the problems of accessibility, mobility & stigma associated with visiting a local food shelf.
- Provides an experience similar to a grocery delivery service; ensures client choice and dietary requests are recorded and adhered to (when applicable).
